#### **Immaculate Conception -** 8<sup>th</sup> December

In order for Mary to give a free assent of her faith to the announcement of her vocation, it was necessary that she be wholly borne by God's grace. For centuries the Church has become more aware that Mary, 'full of grace' through God, was redeemed from the moment of conception. That is what the Immaculate Conception dogma proclaimed (Pope Pius IX 1854). Mary was, from the first moment of conception, by a singular grace and privilege of God and by virtue of the merits of Christ, Saviour of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin." (Catechism # 490-491). The Church teaches that because Mary was chosen to bear the Son of God within her womb, she herself was free from sin from her conception. Mary is the perfect Advent model. Let us pray that, in imitation of her faithfulness, we say "yes" to God's invitation to bring Christ to the world.
