**WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS
AND THE ELDERLY – 28th July 2024**

The IV World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated on Sunday, July 28th 2024. The theme chosen by the Holy Father – “Do not cast me off in my old age” (cf. Psalm 71:9) – is meant to call attention to the fact that, sadly, loneliness is the bitter lot in life of many elderly persons, so often the victims of the throw-away culture. By cherishing the charisms of grandparents and the elderly, and the contribution they make to the life of the Church, we seek to forge bonds between the generations and to combat loneliness. As Scripture states – “It is not good for man to be alone” (Gen 2:18).
