**THINKING OF STUDENTS IN NEED  
AT CHRISTMAS – NFCE**

Poverty is often associated with developing countries when in fact, it exists right here at home. Every day in Niagara, a very large number of students goes to school hungry and waits in line for breakfast. According to recent statistics, nationally, more than 17 percent of children in Canada live in poverty. The Niagara Region combined is just over the national average at 18 percent; however, when looking at the micro level, those numbers increase, especially in St. Catharines, Niagara Falls and Niagara Centre.

According to Food Banks Canada, which maps the vulnerability to poverty according to ridings, St. Catharines riding had 22 percent of children living in poverty, while Niagara Falls and Niagara Centre ridings had a little more than one in every five children, or 20.7 and 20.4 percent respectively, living in poverty and lacking proper nutrition. The Niagara Foundation for Catholic Education is a registered charitable foundation that assists students in need who attend Niagara Catholic District School Board schools.
