WORLD DAY OF PEACE

JANUARY 1st

The World Day of Peace was established by Pope Paul VI in 1968 who asked that “every year, this commemoration be repeated as a hope and as a promise, at the beginning of the calendar which measures and outlines the path of human life in time, that Peace with its just and beneficent equilibrium may dominate the development of events to come.” Each year has a specific theme, chosen by the Holy Father.

Epiphany of the Lord

Epiphany is the story of seekers - who searches, who inquires and asks, is restless, relentless in the quest.

The Magi seek the child king. Herod seeks the answers that will rid him of the threats to his throne and to the delicate power balance he struck with Rome. The chief priests/scribes seek clues hidden in Scripture that point them to the coming of the true Messiah. The people seek to reclaim that which was theirs in long past - the wealth & culture that were the glory of Solomon's Israel.

Matthew's story is not just about seekers long past: it is our story, too. Each one of us is a seeker, scanning the darkness of the void for a glimmer of hope; stretching out weary arms for warmth of love's embrace; straining in the silent stillness for a murmur of faith.

Epiphany - the word means 'manifestation' - God is manifested in Christ in such a way as to leave nothing hidden. What is revealed? God is a seeker! God seeks each of us by name and is, as tireless in relentless pursuit, pleading that we "rise, clasp my hand and come!" (F. Thompson in *Hound of Heaven*) God's promise is made: *I will give what you so desperately seek.*

"PEACE BE WITH YOU"

If peace is not cultivated, lived and protected, aggression spreads into domestic and public life. Logic and confrontation dominates global politics, and deepens instability.

Everyone must sincerely cooperate in the effort to banish fear...and banish war from our minds.

The essential service that religions must render to a suffering humanity is to guard against growing temptation to weaponize even thoughts and words. Let's not drag the language of faith into political battles, to bless nationalism and to justify violence in the name of religion.

Let's hope that every community becomes a home of peace and defuses hostility. We need to free ourselves from evil.

Let us cry out "Enough" to evil, and whisper "Forever" to peace.
