Baptism of the Lord - 11 January

Just like Our Lord submitted completely to the Father's will, we too, with meekness, humility, and great love, must accept the mission Our Father gives to us, even if it proves difficult.

How do we react to an unexpected pregnancy, or to the presence of a handicapped person, or to a frail family member who needs much assistance?

Do we treat life's surprises as hindrances to our plan, or do we accept everything, even the seemingly bad, as a gift? If we learn to let go, the Father will be moved and pleased to accept our offering.

Let us pray for those they who suffer illness, loneliness, or depression - may know that they belong to Jesus Christ, and find peace in Him.
