On this second Sunday of Lent, we move from Jesus' retreat to the desert and temptation by the devil to the glory shown in Jesus' Transfiguration.

The Transfiguration occurs on a mountain in the presence of just three of Jesus' disciples – Peter, James and John, who were sleeping while Jesus prayed. As they awake, Peter and the disciples see Jesus Transfigured and Elijah and Moses present and conversing with Jesus.

The disciples keep secret what they have seen until they also witness his Passion and death when they finally come to an understanding of the Transfiguration.

In his Transfiguration, we see an anticipation of the glory of Jesus' Resurrection as we prepare to remember Jesus' Passion and death.
